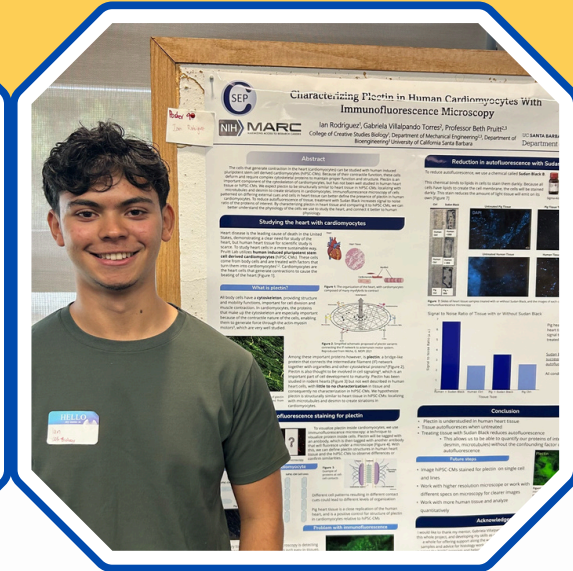

MARC (Maximizing Access to Research Careers) is designed to promote broad participation in the biomedical research workforce and improve student's preparation for Ph.D. graduate training at outstanding universities nationwide. Scholars participate in an onboarding course in the Spring before their 10-week intensive summer research program experience and receive support finding a research lab.

## **Benefits:**

- 2 years of paid/academic year research training (\$14k+ annually)
- \$1,000 for travel to professional conferences
- Support for extramural research experience (REU) in 2nd summer
- Spring 2025 onboarding class: *Practice of Science*
- Access to networking events
- Professional skill and presentation development
- Mentorship on graduate school opportunities

## **Requirements:**

- Apply before Junior Year or if you plan to stay more than 4 years for your undergraduate degree (24 month commitment)
- Science, Engineering, Mathematics majors
- US Citizen or permanent residence status
- May not enroll in summer courses during 10 week program
- No prior research experience needed
